PROJECT DEVELOPMENT AND ENVIRONMENT STUDY

WHAT IS THE BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE OF THE US 1 EXPRESS LANES STUDY?

The Miami-Dade Expressway Authority (MDX), in coordination with Miami-Dade Transit (MDT) and the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), is conducting a Project Development and Environment (PD&E) study that will evaluate the concept of express or managed lanes on the South Dade Busway. The study will analyze potential enhancements to the Busway that could improve existing transit service and safety. It will further evaluate the use of any excess capacity of the Busway by private vehicles paying a toll, which in turn would ease congestion in the parallel US 1 Corridor.

In 2008, the Miami-Dade County Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) conducted a planning analysis of the Busway. The study assessed the feasibility of managed lanes in the right-of-way and the revenue-generating potential of managed lanes to improve traffic mobility and safety, reduce congestion, and meet future travel demands. The MPO concluded it was viable to continue the study.



WHAT ARE THE STUDY LIMITS?

This study would evaluate improvements to the Busway and other associated roadways from approximately SR 9336/SW 344th Street/Palm Drive to just north of SR 878/Snapper Creek Expressway at SW 80th Street. The 19.8 mile-long project passes through Florida City and Homestead, and borders on the Village of Pinecrest, Village of Palmetto Bay, and Town of Cutler Bay.

US 1 EXPRESS PD&E PROCESS




The initial process of data collection and information gathering process will begin in September 2011, with the Agency/Elected Official and Public Kick-off Meetings to inform everyone that improvements along the US 1 Corridor are being studied. Technical workshops will be held next year to review different alternatives, gather feedback from project stakeholders, and strategize on how to address potential impacts. Throughout the duration of the study, several opportunities to provide input on the project will continue to be made available. Final recommendations regarding corridor improvements will be presented at a formal Public Hearing anticipated for the Summer of 2013.



WHAT ARE THE GOALS OF THE STUDY?

- Enhance transit service and improve traffic operations along the South Miami-Dade Busway
- Maximize usage of existing roadway capacity and existing right-of-way
- Mitigate congestion along the US 1 Corridor and traversing streets
- Provide possible funding for future transit improvements
- Invest in the South Miami-Dade Greenway to improve the pedestrian and bicycle experience
